

INFORMATION LETTER
on the holding of a research work competition

DEAR STUDENTS!

For the purpose of developing students' research activities, supporting the innovative ideas of young people, forming research competencies, and stimulating the scientific potential of students, a competition of student research papers on the topic "Social Sciences and Humanities in the Context of Global Transformations: Challenges and Strategies for Societal Development" will be held at Zhetysu University named after I. Zhansugurov on April 28-29, 2026. The competition is aimed at identifying promising student studies devoted to current issues in the development of society, the economy, law, education, and other fields of the social sciences and humanities.

Competition participants:

Students enrolled in bachelor's degree programs who present research papers on issues related to the social sciences and humanities are invited to participate in the competition. The competition will be held in the format of a public presentation of the results of student research, including an online format for out-of-town participants.

Requirements for formatting materials:

Original student research papers corresponding to the competition theme are accepted for participation.

Only one research work is accepted from each contestant.

The working languages of the competition are **Kazakh, Russian, and English.**

All submitted papers undergo a preliminary review and a check for plagiarism.

The research work must be 10-15 pages in length (excluding appendices).

The work must be prepared in Microsoft Word and formatted in accordance with the following requirements:

- font - Times New Roman
- font size - 12 pt
- line spacing - 1.0
- margins on all sides - 20 mm
- first-line indent - 1.25 cm

The materials shall be submitted as follows:

A research work and a presentation for public defense (10-20 slides).

Structure of the research paper

The research work must include the following elements:

1. title page;
2. contents;
3. main text, including:
 - relevance of the research;
 - research aim and objectives;
 - research methods;
 - main results;
 - practical significance;

- conclusions;
- 4. tables, figures, and diagrams (if any) with mandatory numbering and indication of sources;
- 5. list of references;
- 6. Appendices.

The list of references must include at least 25 sources. The use of contemporary scholarly publications is encouraged.

The list of references shall be formatted in accordance with **GOST 7.1-2003**.

The originality level of the research work must be at least **75%**. All borrowed material must be accompanied by references to the sources. The authors bear responsibility for the accuracy of the data presented and for compliance with the standards of academic integrity.

Evaluation criteria:

The evaluation of the research papers submitted to the competition shall be carried out by an expert commission according to the following criteria:

1. relevance of the research topic and the degree of its scientific substantiation;
2. novelty, independence, and research value of the study;
3. practical significance and the possibility of applying the results obtained;
4. quality of the methodology, argumentation, and overall elaboration of the study;
5. level of the public defense of the work and the quality of responses to the questions of the expert commission.

Summing up and awards:

The winners of the competition shall be determined on the basis of the final expert evaluation of the submitted research papers and the results of their public defense.

Based on the results of the competition, the winners shall be awarded diplomas of the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd degree, and all participants shall receive certificates.

The prize fund of the competition amounts to 500,000 tenge: 1st place - 200,000 tenge; 2nd place - two prizes of 100,000 tenge each; 3rd place - two prizes of 50,000 tenge each.

The prize fund has been formed from sponsorship funds.
